Early December we see the start of "Round Two" of the facilities development with the laying of the artificial turf. Covering two full size pitches and a training area, this is set to further transform the club. On completion, Western Springs will have a world class facility almost solely for the enjoyment of year round football. I would like to recognise in particular Zoran Jerkovic for all the long hours he has put into this project. It is the intention that we make the most of the new fields and facilities by developing closer relationships with neighbouring schools, communities and surrounding facilities. 2013 will also see a focus on getting as many existing members of the club back playing or training at Seddon Fields with no weather interruption and expanded training times, additional Friday night and Saturday game time slots. Much in the way that Junior football has helped transform Friday nights at Seddon Fields, imagine the atmosphere of a Friday 7pm or Saturday 5pm kick off just off the deck of the clubrooms!

In the recent months, the Senior and Junior Club have been collectively looking at creating a clear Junior to Senior Player pathway. It is a key issue for a club looking to develop its own home grown players. Look out for an announcement on this mid January.

The Western Springs Football Club would cease to function if not for a lot of time given freely by an awful lot of individuals. Not just those that involve themselves on the committees but the grade coordinators from the 6th through to the 17th grade, the coaches, some of whom take more than one team, the managers of the Junior and Youth teams, and of course the players who proudly wear our strip.

At Western Springs there are now somewhere around 2,000 of us, and growing!










MESSAGE FROM THE JUNIOR/ YOUTH COMMITTEE

Stop the Press!! Work Commences on World Class Pitches at your Club... Western Springs AFC!

It is with a great deal of excitement that the Committee can now announce that work has commenced on the installation of two full size pitches and two training pitches at Seddon Fields. As background, this is a major coup for the Club with Western Springs picking up the bulk of Auckland City Councils funding for 2012/2013 in terms of artificial pitch installation. This was down to the hard work of the Committee over the past two years involving submissions to a number of Councils, ongoing meetings and discussions with key Council members to achieve this fantastic result. While the Committee started with a discussion around one pitch, to end up with the final result shown is a major achievement. This will mean that combined with our new facilities, Western Springs will have the best facilities offered in the country.

What you will see at the Club this week is the erection of temporary fencing as work commences on the project. This is a Council led project and they have awarded the contract to Wilkinson Civil Ltd. They will be setting up the site this week including fencing around the whole of the Seddon #1 and 2 fields so that excavation can commence. The work is currently estimated to

take around 24 weeks and should be completed in early May 2013, however we will ensure that Club members are informed of on-going changes as they arise. While there may be some disruption to the beginning of the next season, this is a bit of short term pain for a great gain and we do expect this to be minimal!

In term of the construction, the Designers of the project are Harrison Grierson who will carry out project management and site observation. Specifically the installation will result in two full size fields at 100m x 65m and two junior fields 50m x 32.5m, plus an upgrade in our lighting to international game standard. The Council has also completed the

tender for the installation of the turf and this has been awarded to Greenfields SportsTurf Sytems and you can view other projects of theirs at the following website http://www.greenfields. eu/. The pitch itself is MX-60 Evolution and will be installed to a Fifa 2 rating.


With this change we will have the option of having increased training at our home ground, plus football played at Seddon Fields rain or shine. The general frustration of Seddon fields with cancellations should be a thing of the past!

Congratulations and thankyou once again to those involved in this project, we will all be looking forward to stepping out onto these pitches in the New Year!
