This issue, please let me introduce Glen Milner, our Vice-President ...



FOR those of you I haven't met, I am the Vice-President of the Association. I am also the only foundation member of the Association's Committee of Management, having commenced in the role of Assistant Secretary when the then Northern District Basketball Association (the forerunner of what is now BBA Inc.) was formed in 1978.

Apart from a three year stint during the early 2000s when I was President of Basketball Victoria and on the Board of Basketball Australia, I have occupied Executive roles with BBA since 1978, at various times leading the Association's business as President and also as Director of Basketball Operations.

A well-rounded capability set in both the domestic and elite basketball settings has included player, refereeing and coaching roles, although I am the first to concede that my coaching achievements far exceed any notable playing or refereeing milestones.

A swag of premierships at the junior and senior domestic levels in Broadmeadows and beyond has been complemented by the 1997 and 2001 VJBL Under-18 Women's Victorian State Championship titles. In addition, our Association has enjoyed a great deal of success in our representative women's program, achieving back-to-back titles in 2007 and 2008, and finishing runners up in the Australian Club Championships in 2007.

The hard working BBA Committees of the past have put a lot of effort into setting the Association up for a very promising future. A sound financial basis has enabled us to achieve expansion of the Dimboola Road stadium as well as a licensing agreement with the Hume City Council. With the new blood recruited on to the existing

Committee of Management and a progressive staffing structure catering for the current and emerging needs of all sectors of our basketball community, we are very well placed to have Broadmeadows Basketball as:

- (Association of choice for competition and player, coach, referee and administrator development in this region;
- the leader in engagement initiatives that build better communities and
- the provider of career pathways in sports administration and player, referee and coaching excellence.

I also acknowledge the efforts of our Junior Domestic Sub-Committee in helping this arm of our operations become even more responsive to our

Clubs' needs. The next challenge is to get our Junior Representative Sub-Committee established, so don't be surprised if I start tapping you on the shoulder to become involved!

Finally, what a fantastic and professionally conducted junior domestic final series we had, culminating in the carnival type atmosphere of Grand Final day. Congratulations go to Lisa Shennan, our Operations Manager, who led the organisational arrangements for the day, and to all the Clubs who participated with a strong sense of goodwill to provide very positive messages for our young participants. I also encourage you to come along and support our Hume City Big V senior representative teams - our men and women's teams have got off to great starts, while our development squads continue to give a good account of themselves.


First things first. What constitutes Rep, I hear you ask?

A further 4 teams Represent Broadmeadows in the Big V which is the Basketball Victoria Senior competition for both men and women. Big V also includes a Youth League competition for players under 23 years of age. The Big V is further split into Championship, Division 1 and Division 2 competitions with Broadmeadows excelling by having 3 teams in the elite "Championship division", the highest State competition. Something our neighbors desire but are unable to match.


