

Time!

Knowing where to start

Working out why our current practices are not working

Deciding who should do it

Knowing what good practices are



Time.....

We cant get any more of it, but we can:

- improve our systems and practices,
- share the load

....and in doing so, the processes and systems take less time, and people feel freed and supported.



An example of the value of spending
some time to create more time...

Consider your club's induction process....

A new volunteer starts in your club.....

How does your club manage this?



Do you have an induction process?

Is the process written down?

Is there an induction manual/booklet/folder you can hand to new volunteers?

Are several different people in the club capable of inducting someone?



Consequences of not inducting new volunteers well:

- they may not do their job well (**time** needed to get them up to speed),
- there may be complaints (**time** needed to deal with the complaints)
- they may constantly ask questions, require things (**time** needed for someone to do this)
- something might go wrong (**time** needed to correct it)
- they may feel unsupported and may quit (**time** needed replacing them)



Initial time and energy spent on the induction process...

....will save you **TIME** in the very near future,

....**AND** share the load!

Volunteer Roles

So once you've attracted some volunteers, what are you offering them?

Note home from school this week:

Tick a box:

Would you like to be:

- Coach
- Umpire
- Team Manager



An alternative could have been:

We would hope all families will be involved where they can, so please indicate how you (or another family member) could help by ticking 3 boxes below:

- Help organise the equipment pre-season
- Keep track of the equipment
- Write roster for set-up/scoring/base umpire
- Umpire some games (not all)
- Coach the team (help provided)
- Be an assistant coach
- Fill in for the coach 2 or 3 times
- Help manage the kids at some trainings



- **Other considerations when attracting volunteers:**

- Offer a mixture of shorter and longer term roles.
- Put a time limit (tenure) on all of them, so they can see that it isn't forever
- Keep in touch with people who leave, they may want to return one day
- Look outside of the club, not all of your volunteers have to come from within – **V-STAR - Diversity**

- Spend **time** to make time
(eg get your induction process sorted)
- Look at having a **Volunteer coordinator** or team
- Try to **attract** your volunteers not recruit them
 - is your **club culture** good – do a **survey**
 - How do you **promote** your club?
 - **Share the load** -try to break down some roles into parts
- Get onto **V-STAR!**,
 - do the **quiz**,
 - create your **Action Plan**,
 - download some **templates**
