A TIME TO REFLECT ON ANZAC DAY

PHIL and Shari Brown might be thousands of kilometres a part, but when the Last Post echoes through the city on Anzac Day, it will be like they are standing right next to each other.

Shari will be at local Anzac Day Service in Melbourne, while her husband, Phil, will be at Camp Baird in the Middle East, serving for Australia.

Phil is a member of the Royal Australian Air Force and has been for the past 35 years.

He is currently on his sixth deployment, his fourth to the Middle East.

While he couldn't disclose his location when we spoke, he could say he had been overseas for almost six months and was expected to return to his home in Hoppers Crossing within days.

Phil said Anzac Day was an occasion that meant a lot to Australians in the Middle East.

He said it was something he looked forward to each year, because it was a day to remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice for our country.

"Anzac Day is a time of reflection of the people who have served and are currently serving," Phil said.

"It is about honouring these people and paying respect.

"We will be having a ceremony here, there will be Anzac Day ceremonies all over the Middle East.

"We will play the Last Post, it will be identical to what will happen back home."

Footy has now become synonymous with Anzac Day.

The Collingwood and Essendon Football Clubs have owned the day for more than 20 years.

The match has become one of the biggest games of the home and away season, but it isn't just about playing a game of footy, it is about paying respect to those who have and are currently serving for this country.

Phil said the connection between football and the meaning of Anzac Day was so strong because footballers and those in the military both shared the same values.

"Footy is about mateship and the military is built on mateship," he said.

Phil decided to join the Airforce back in November 1981 because he enjoyed travelling.

He is a currently a Procurement Liaison and is a responsible

for a small team whose aim is to support all local procurement requests.

"I get up at 6am, I go to work, have breakfast, go back to work, have lunch and it goes on," he said.

"I do that 13 out of every 14 days.

"In our summer the weather it is reasonable, it is easing up 35 degrees now, but, it can get up to over 50 degrees, that's when it is unbearable."

As well as being a proud Australian servicemen, he is also a proud member of the Tarneit Football Club.

The 51-year-old has been involved with the club since its inception three years ago.

The Titans are never far from his mind, he wears the club T-Shirt wherever he goes.

Not one to miss chance to promote his club, the father of three used this opportunity to thank those involved with Tarneit and encourage juniors to get on board in 2016 and beyond.

"I want to send a big thank you to the people at Tarneit and the wonderful sponsors, without them we wouldn't be a club.

"We are also always looking for juniors, so new players are welcome."

WRFL LAUNCH NEW JUNIOR COMPETITION

ABOUT 75 junior footballers got the chance to play on Whitten Oval on Sunday as part of the launch of the WRFL's newest competition, Under-8's.

With six teams competing in the inaugural competition, the enthusiastic youngsters got the chance to walk in the footsteps of their Western Bulldogs heroes.

WRFL Football Operations and Club Development officer Tim Shellcot said it was a fantastic gala day.

"Everyone has come with the right attitude, everyone is having a lot of fun, coaches and umpires are doing the right thing," he said.

Shellcot said the reason why the WRFL chose to introduce an Under-8 competition was because there needed to be a clearer pathway between Auskick and club football.

"There is a disconnect between Auskick and competitive club football, so the Under-8's is a way of trying to bridge that gap," he said.

"It is about trying to get players into club jumpers and get them more enthusiastic about playing competitive football and also trying to get them to become long term club players in the league."

Shellcot said the Western Bulldogs Football Club have been a great supporter of the league for several years now.

"The Dogs have been a really good supporter of our junior competition for four or five years and they are keen to get involved with all younger age groups," he said.

"They have opened up their facility and the ground to support the launch."

Western Bulldogs Schools and Clubs coordinator Glenn Balmforth said it was great the club was able to give back to the local community.

"It is great that we can give back to the community through the WRFL and try and increase participation in the west and create a fantastic experience for the kids who one day could potentially play for the Western Bulldogs," he said.

Shane Williams kicked five goals for the Eagles whilst Michael Volpi kicked four.


This week will see Glen Orden make their way to Caroline Springs, where the Lakers are favourites to win, but the Hawks are keen to prove everyone wrong.

MENTORING JUNIOR UMPIRES THE WAY FORWARD

NOW that the season is a few weeks old, it is important to highlight one vital aspect of our football, the mentoring program that is currently happening within the umpiring fraternity.

Those familiar with the junior ranks, have witnessed many examples over the past few years of trainee field umpires following the more experienced fieldies in a game.

After a week or two, the responsibilities are shared until the trainee has grown in confidence and developed enough understanding of the rules and positioning to be in control of their own game.

Likewise, on the boundary the trainees gather follow the footsteps of the senior boundary rider until they are sufficient in their knowledge to run solo or with a partner.

In an era when the majority of WRFL boundary umpires are in their teens, occasionally there will be Mark Westgarth striding around the boundary with a collection of youngsters streaming behind.

The goalies have a system where the young new aspirants attend a WRFL and stand behind the fence keeping a close eye on all the movements and mannerisms of the appointed goal umpire.

The next step is to actually be on the inside of the fence standing next to or behind an experienced goalie, asking questions, discussing positioning and becoming familiar with the role of a WRFL goal umpire.

Prior to the season, the WRFL Umpires' Association applied for and was successful in gaining a small grant to help fund the developing mentoring program.

This allowed the association to appoint specific mentors to concentrate on the first year umpires and provide them with skilled instructors.

Feedback by the mentors also helps the young umpires to reflect upon their umpiring and work on areas that may need further development in.

Keep your eye open this week and see if you can spot any of the young trainees out in the field, running the boundaries or waving the flags.



LAWS OF THE GAME – QUIZ #2


