### **Notice of Race**

29 May, 26 June, 17 July, 7 August & 28 August 2016

#### 1 RULES

All races will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

All competitors shall be members of RYCT or any club affiliated with Yachting Tasmania. All entries for the series shall be on the official entry form accompanied by the prescribed fee and be lodged with the Organising Authority by 0930 hours on the first day of the series. Casual entries for individual races of the series must be lodged with the Race Committee by 0930 hours on the day of the race.

The entry fee for the series will be \$20. The entry fee for individual races will be \$5.

#### 3 CLASSES

The following classes are invited to enter: Sabots, Optimists, Cadets, Flying 11s, Lasers, 420s, 29ers, B14s, Moths, Sharpies, Int.2.4s. Other classes will be invited to enter at the discretion of the Race Committee.

#### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 7 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the Derwent River between Battery Point and Long Point.

#### 8 COURSES

The courses will be described in detail in the Sailing Instructions

#### 9 SCORING

Each day of racing shall be scored individually, with Low Point Scoring applied to the race or races on the day. Ties will be broken according to RRS Appendix A7.

#### 10 PRIZES

Prizes will be at the discretion of RYCT OTB and will be awarded at the end of each day of sailing. A series prize will be awarded to the winners of classes with more than five starters in 75% of races.

#### 11 ENTRY DISCLAIMER

It is the competitor's decision to enter an event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry in the Event competitors shall indemnify the Organising Authority, the host sailing club, their officers, members, servants and agents in respect to all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the event.

The Organising Authority, the host sailing club, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the event or howsoever arising in connection with the event.
