

Nominations are being sought for all Junior South Adelaide teams for the 2016/17 basketball year.

The South Adelaide Basketball Club actively encourages players, parents, members and all those interested in coaching to apply to coach within the South Adelaide Junior Program. The input of a Coach on the Junior program as a whole and in particular those within a team/squad is invaluable and all of the Club greatly appreciates the sacrifice, passion and dedication of our coaches.

The Club continues to refine the Junior Program to ensure all players are playing in appropriate grades and competitions to ensure their best opportunity to develop. We believe further changes to our Junior Program structure will assist both players and coaches to continue to commit to their basketball and the Club, as well as provide development pathways for all our junior members.

Division 1 Age Group Coaches

The appointment process for Division 1 coaches is managed by the Junior Program Manager, Basketball Operations Manager and Basketball Operations Sub-Committee and appointments ratified by the Club Executive Committee. The Division 1 Coach is accountable for planning, developing, coordinating and ensuring that the basketball training programs being delivered within that age program addresses improvement in the basic sound fundamentals and skills of the club's players and coaches.

The Division 1 Coach has an obligation to develop their program beyond an individual season or a particular team/group of players. As such the Division 1 Coach shall be structuring their program around the on-going development of ALL players with that age group. The on-going development role of a Division 1 Coach requires the understanding of coaching players within a program rather than coaching an individual team.

Roles and Responsibilities

1. attend training sessions, games, state championships and provide opportunity for players to attend and play in tournaments (where appropriate);

2. attend training sessions, games etc for the other teams within their program (where appropriate).

3. assist coaches within their program through providing opportunity, resource material and advice (where appropriate) to aid the development of individual and team coaching skills.

- 4. play a major role in the team/player selection process, for that age program.
- 5. assist with the administrational duties for that age program (as required).
- 6. attend meeting requirements of the SABC.

Division 2 and Below Coaches

Division 2 and below coach appointments follow those of the Division 1 positions. These appointments are made by the Junior Program Manager and Basketball Operations Manager in consultation with the Age Group Division 1 coach as well as the Basketball Operations Sub-Committee.

Domestic Coaches (SDJBL)

Domestic coach positions will be made by the Basketball Operations Manager, Junior Program Manager and the SDJBL Coordinator. These positions won't be notified until mid-September 2016. Our domestic program is a great program to start out in if you're new into coaching or if you are an experienced coach and would like to go back into the grass roots of basketball development. Our SDJBL coordinator will act as a mentor to coaches in this program. If you wish to nominate for a domestic position please mark write 'domestic' in the table below where division is requested.
