FUNDRAISING POLICY

The Diamond Valley Basketball Association executive recognises the necessity for teams and groups to raise funds for upcoming National Championships and Diamond Valley USA Tours. The following is policy, more specific to both of the mentioned occasions.

In accordance with the Diamond Valley Basketball Association Fundraising Policy, permission must be sought from the Chief Executive Officer. Fundraising should not compete with the DVBA. Fundraising should not affect business of the DVBA, management, domestic competitions, Junior and Senior Eagles representative competitions or compete with the Association's sponsors.

- Fundraising is the responsibility of the team or group.
- The team or group is to organise their own fundraising committee providing the names of the committee along with individual's responsibilities to the Junior Championship Committee.
- Any commitments made to bookings prior to the finalisation of sufficient fundraising will be the obligation of the team or group to honour.
- The DVBA will not bear responsibility for costs incurred or committed to where fundraising is found to be insufficient
- The budget the committee is working towards is to be supplied to the Junior Championship Committee.
- The proposed fundraising list of events needs to be submitted to the Junior Championship Committee.
- All funds generated will be deposited through the DVBA's banking process.
- The distribution of funds during the event is to be managed by two adults previously named to the Junior Championship Committee.
- Funds raised are to be equally distributed between all participants.
- Funds raised should not be used in any way that could be considered extravagant, wasteful or untoward.
- The Fundraising committee will be required to provide a complete reconciliation to the Junior Championship Committee no later than a month after the event has completed.
- Where funds raised exceed the cost incurred, it will be at the Junior Championship Committee's discretion as to how the remainder is treated.
