CBL Men 2015/16 – Squad Announcement

Congratulations to all competitors who attended try-outs for this year. It was certainly hotly contested.

We now move into pre-season, with up to two more cuts prior to the final team selection.

Pre-season sees selected senior athletes joining the development squad for final selection. The development squad were well represented at try-outs by Jack Dodd, James Metaxotos, Luke Liesegang, Brad Butler, Dean Campbell and Tasman Clark. They performed to a high standard and will be pushing for roster spots.

Some hard decisions had to be made considering team competitiveness, team balance and with an eye on future development. Selection was based on the elements outlined in our CBL guidelines being condition, eligibility and the TEAM criteria:

Tenacious - We compete hard and never allow easy baskets; we have excellence in attitude as demonstrated by player willingness to push themselves to improve as an individual by 'trying-out' with 100% intensity, focus and effort;

Executers - We show fundamental basketball skills and play our roles; we have excellence in basketball fundamentals as per the WBI Player Development Program;

Assisters - We pass the ball unselfishly and are stingy defenders; we have a high Level of teamwork and leadership as demonstrated by assistance, encouragement and support of other players;

Mindful - We are coachable, composed under pressure and good sports; our level of coachability is demonstrated by player adaptability and willingness to accept constructive criticism from coaches.
